We're still engaging our students via virtual programming. We ask students how they're feeling on a scale of 1-5 and make sure to help them process their emotions every day.

Providence Center received special recognition from the Census Bureau for our work in collaboration with Philly Counts, a city-wide initiative to bring awareness of the importance of proper representation in the census for communities of color. Our staff and Youth Advocates were able to reach out to over 3,000 individuals in the Fairhill area via phone banking and non-contact canvassing. This is part of our work to ensure that Fairhill residents have access to the resources they need to improve their lives.
